Nothing is more rewarding than finishing a marathon! Our students have the opportunity to not only run 26.2 miles, but to also foster a love of books, and give back to our wonderful community!

Students in **grades 3, 4 & 5**, will commit to reading **26 books**, performing **deeds in the community totaling 26 deed points**, and running a total of **26.2 miles**. The MFL club will meet after school to discuss books, deeds, stretching, nutrition, and run under the supervision of Marathon for Life coaches and administrators. Students will run their final 1.2 miles in a "race" to earn their Finisher's t-shirt and medal.
