## 2017-2018 School Calendar

The Klein ISD School Calendar is now finalized. You can find it on the Klein ISD website. Please use this calendar as you plan trips, vacations, and appointments for next year. We want your children to be in school every day! Good school attendance in elementary school helps children develop necessary skills and build good habits for a successful future. Missing just 10% of the school year, which is about 17 days, can have serious implications. We encourage you to send your children to school every day, unless they are ill or have a fever. When absences are necessary, remember to send a note to school within 5 days. In addition to being at school every day, it is also important to be on time! Did you know that being just 5 minutes late each day can add up to 3.4 days of missed instructional time in the course of a year???

Our school hours for next year will be 8:15-3:35. Students will be able to enter the building at 7:50. Please do not drop them off prior to 7:50 as supervision will not be available. Dismissal will start at 3:35. If extended time in the morning or afternoon will be helpful for your family, please consider signing up for Campus Kids for before/after school care.
